I would like to introduce you to the **humbleness** of Jesus.

 His humbleness shown through <u>Him</u> becoming one of <u>us.</u>

Philippians 2:5-8a NLT

- <sup>5</sup> You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.
- <sup>6</sup>Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

<sup>7</sup>Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being.

When he appeared in human form, <sup>8</sup> he humbled himself in obedience to God.



John 2:3 NLT

<sup>3</sup> So he left Judea and returned to Galilee.



Hebrews 4:15 NLT

<sup>15</sup> This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin.

II. His humbleness shown through His invitation to <u>partner</u> with Him.

John 1:35-39 NLT

<sup>35</sup> The following day John was again standing with two of his disciples. <sup>36</sup> As Jesus walked by, John looked at him and declared, "Look! There is the Lamb of God!"<sup>37</sup> When John's two disciples heard this, they followed Jesus.



<sup>38</sup> Jesus looked around and saw them following. "What do you want?" he asked them.

They replied, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?"

<sup>39</sup> "Come and see," he said. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon when they went with him to the place where he was staying, and they remained with him the rest of the day.
