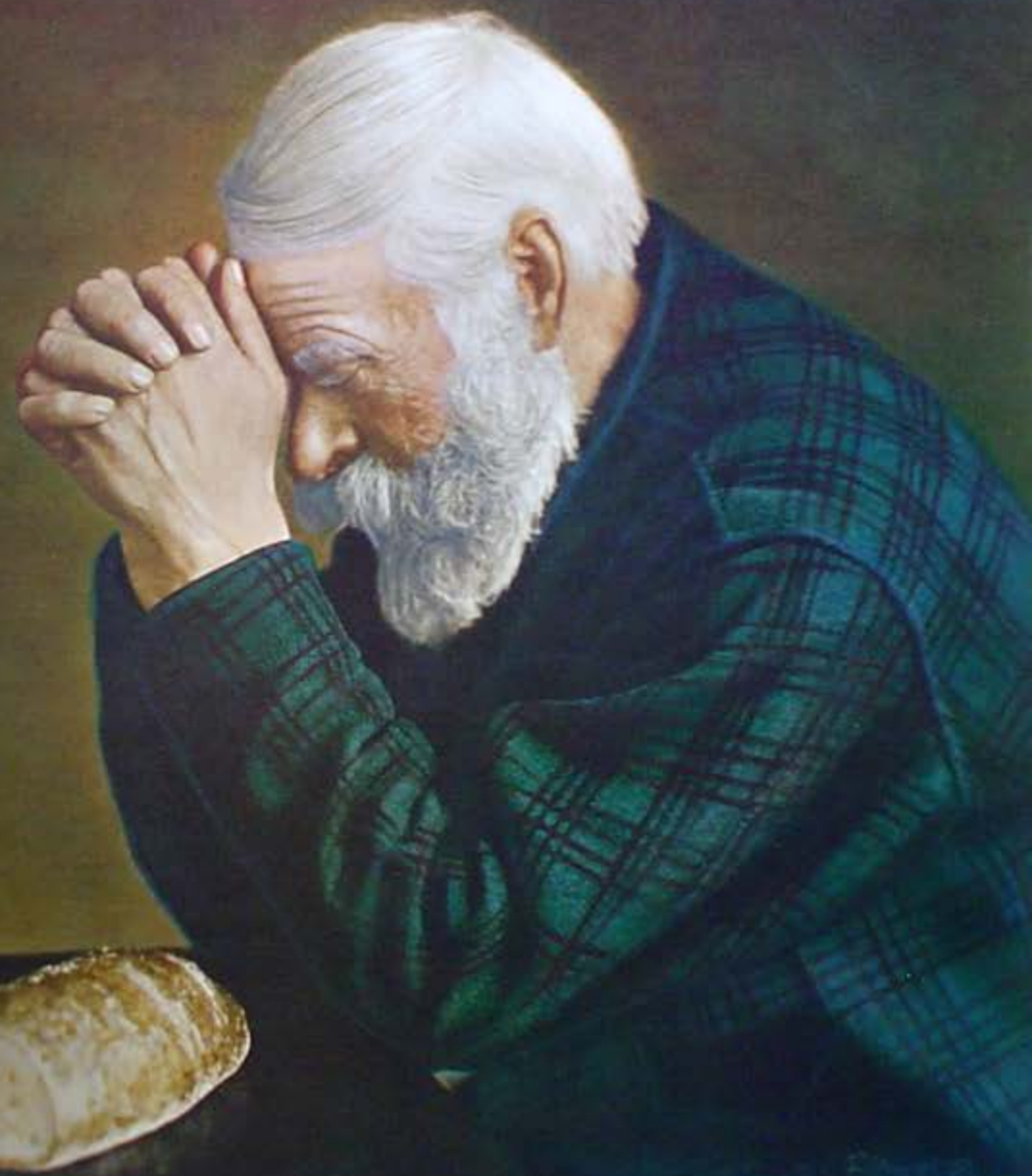
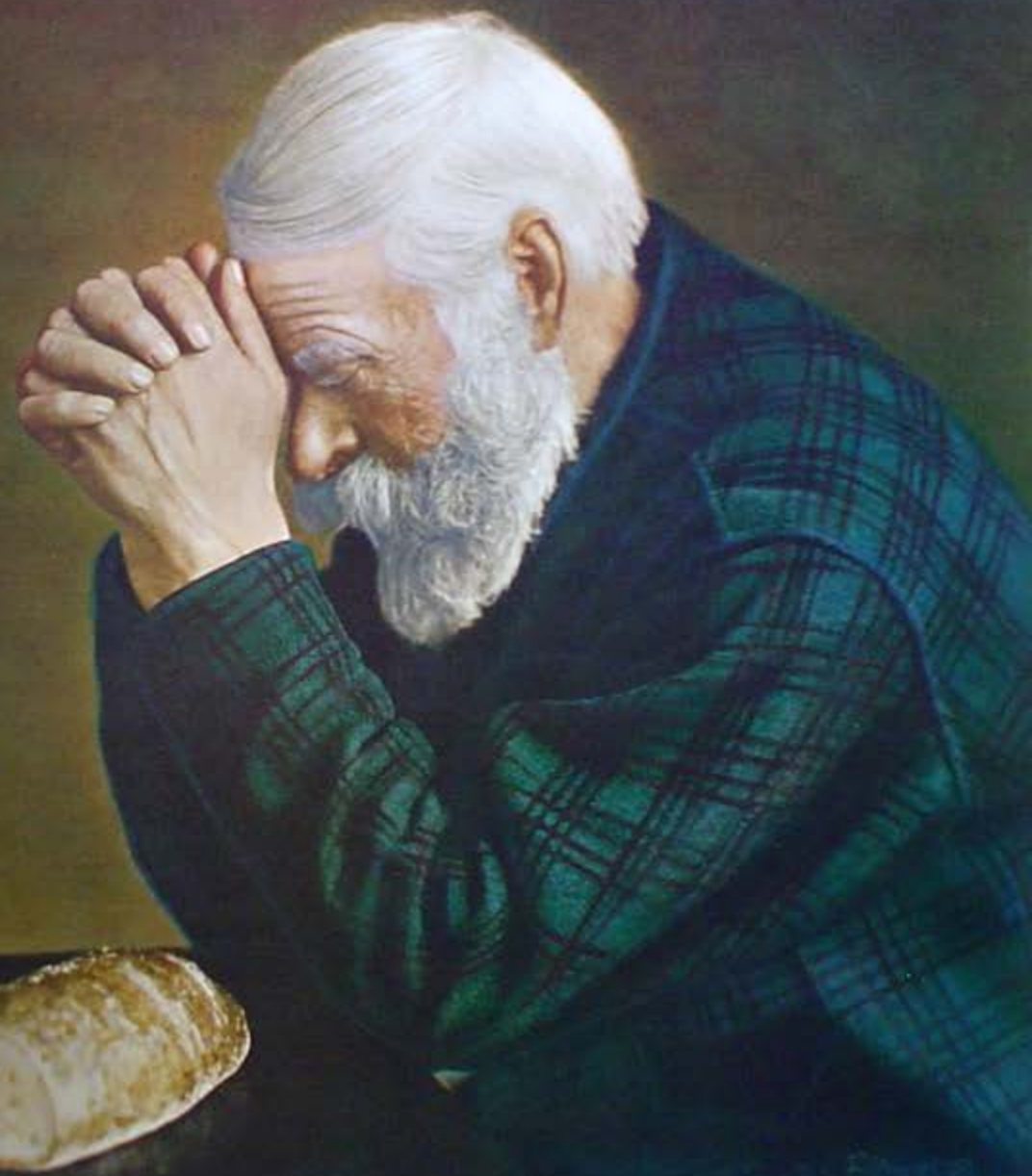

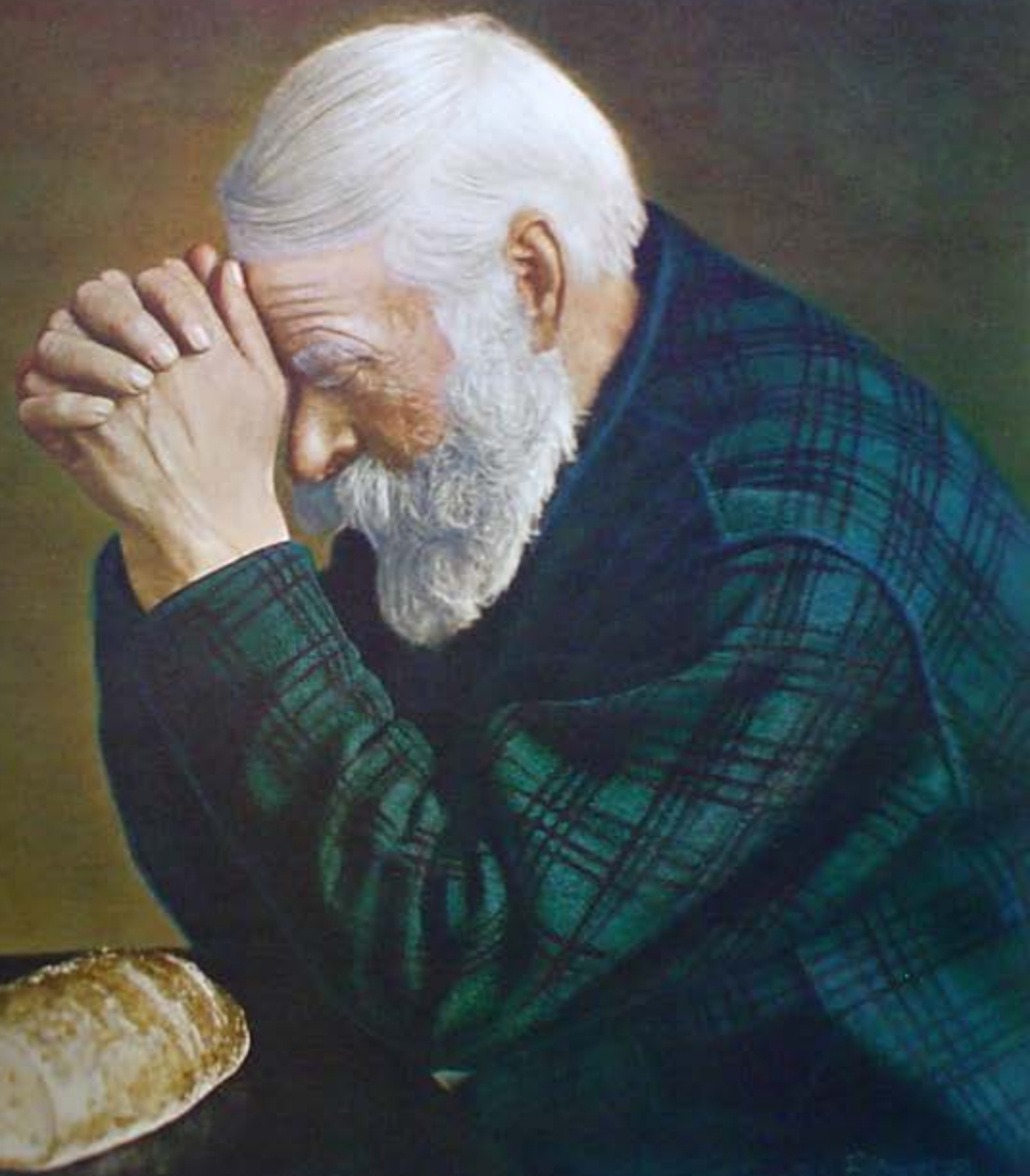


The Hebrew word for wisdom is *KHOKHMAH* which means *SKILL* for living.

in HUMILITY.

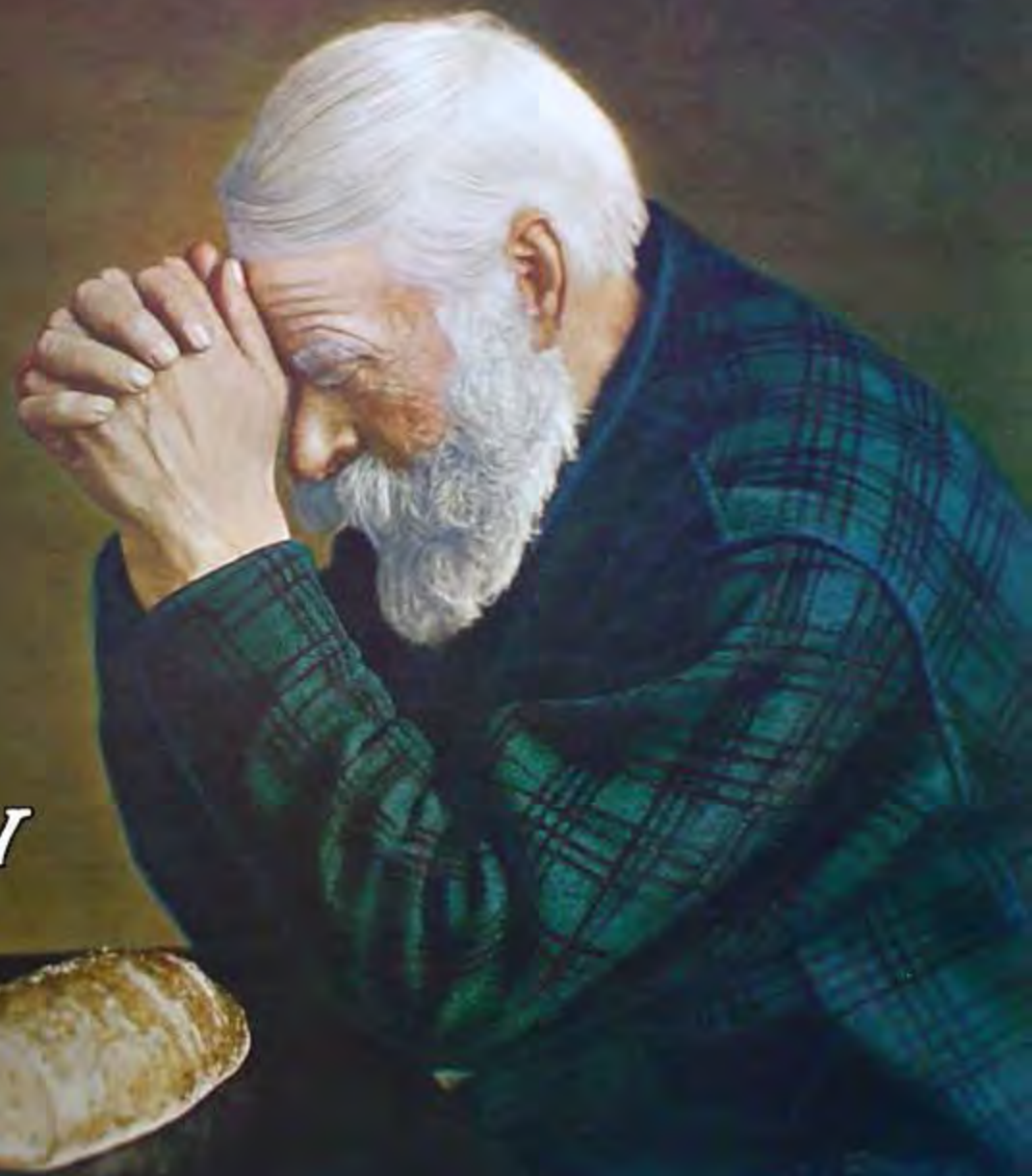


<sup>18</sup> Pride goes before destruction,

than to share plunder with the proud.

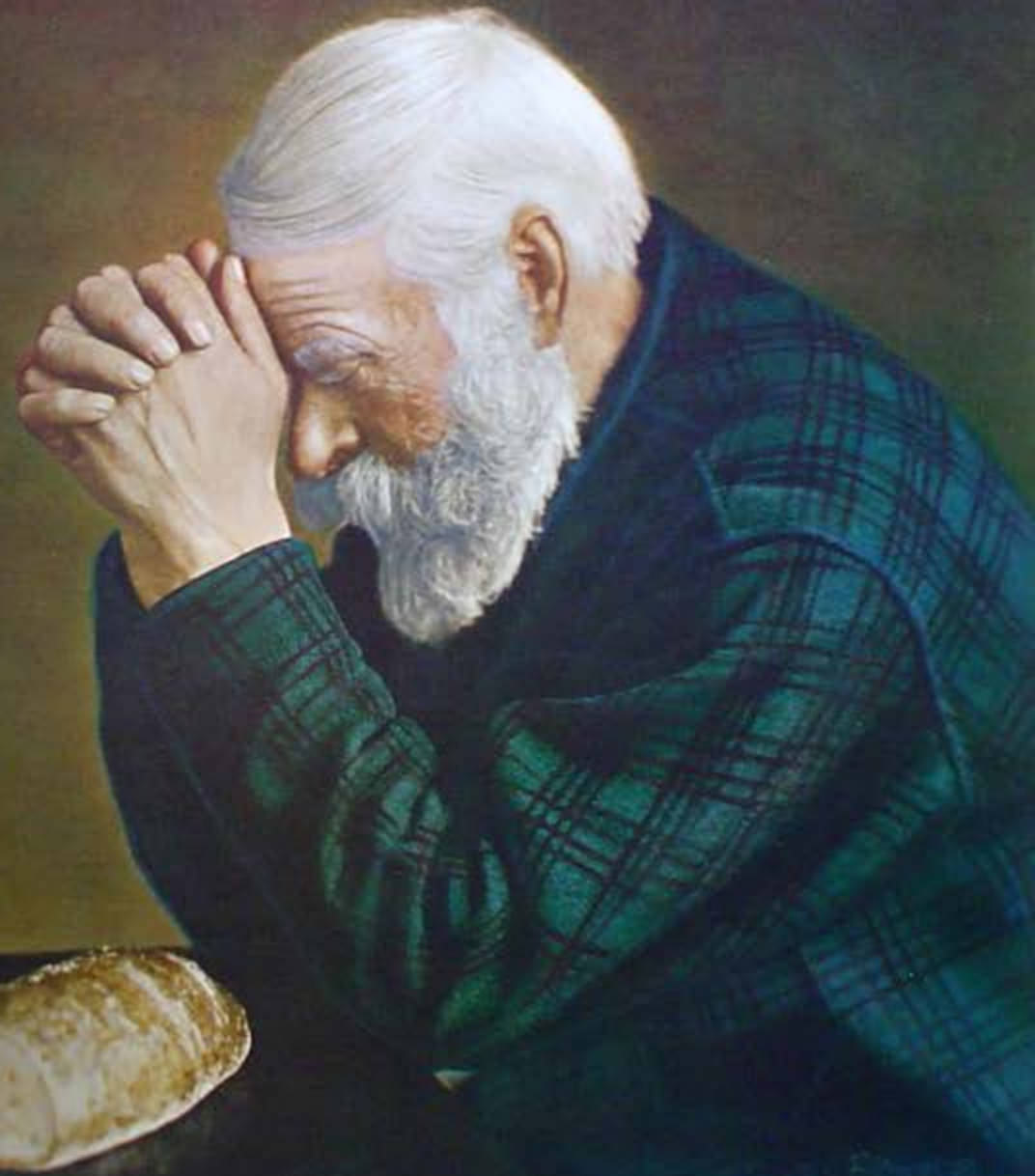

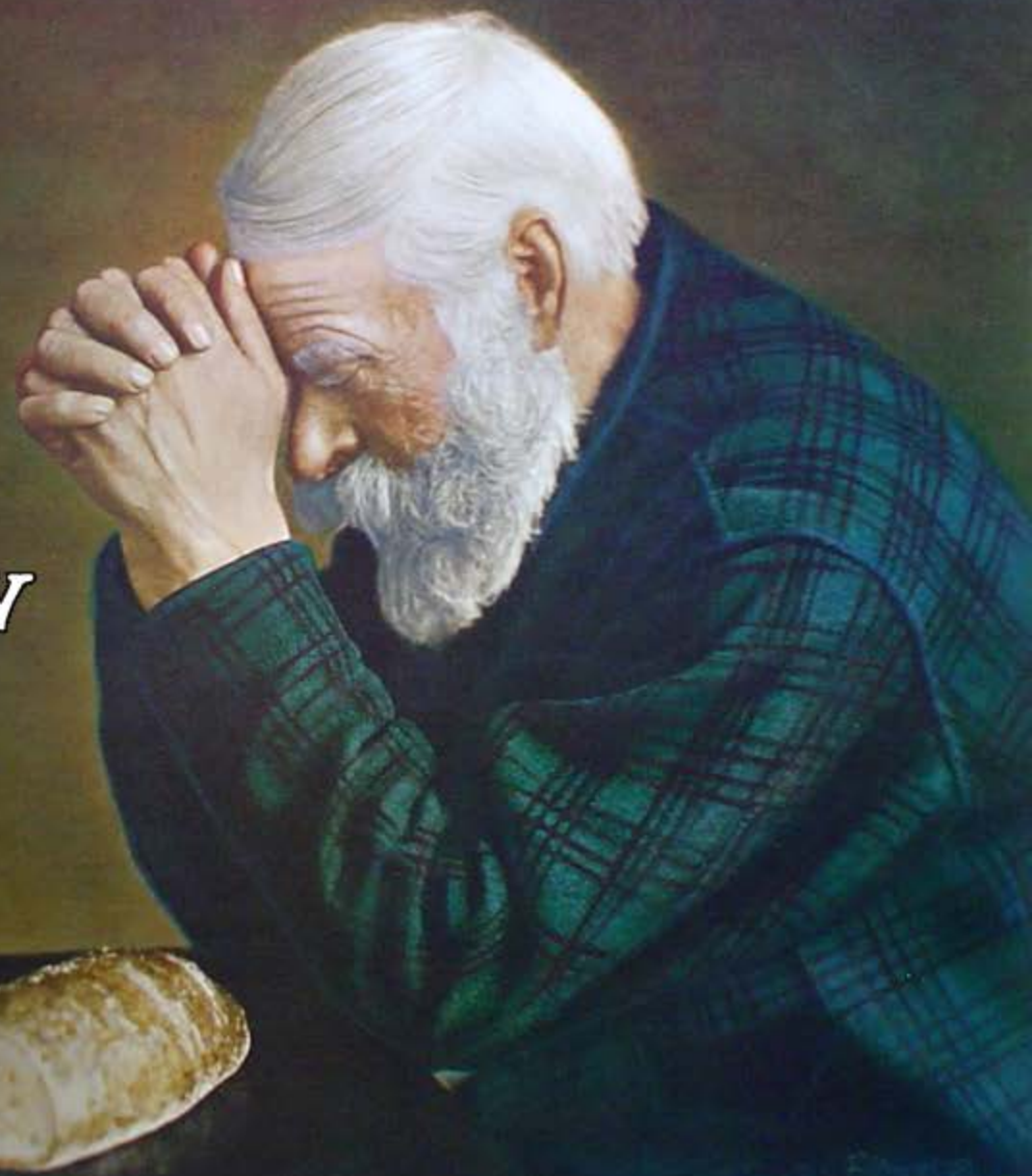
HUMILITY PREVENTS  
DESTRUCTION.



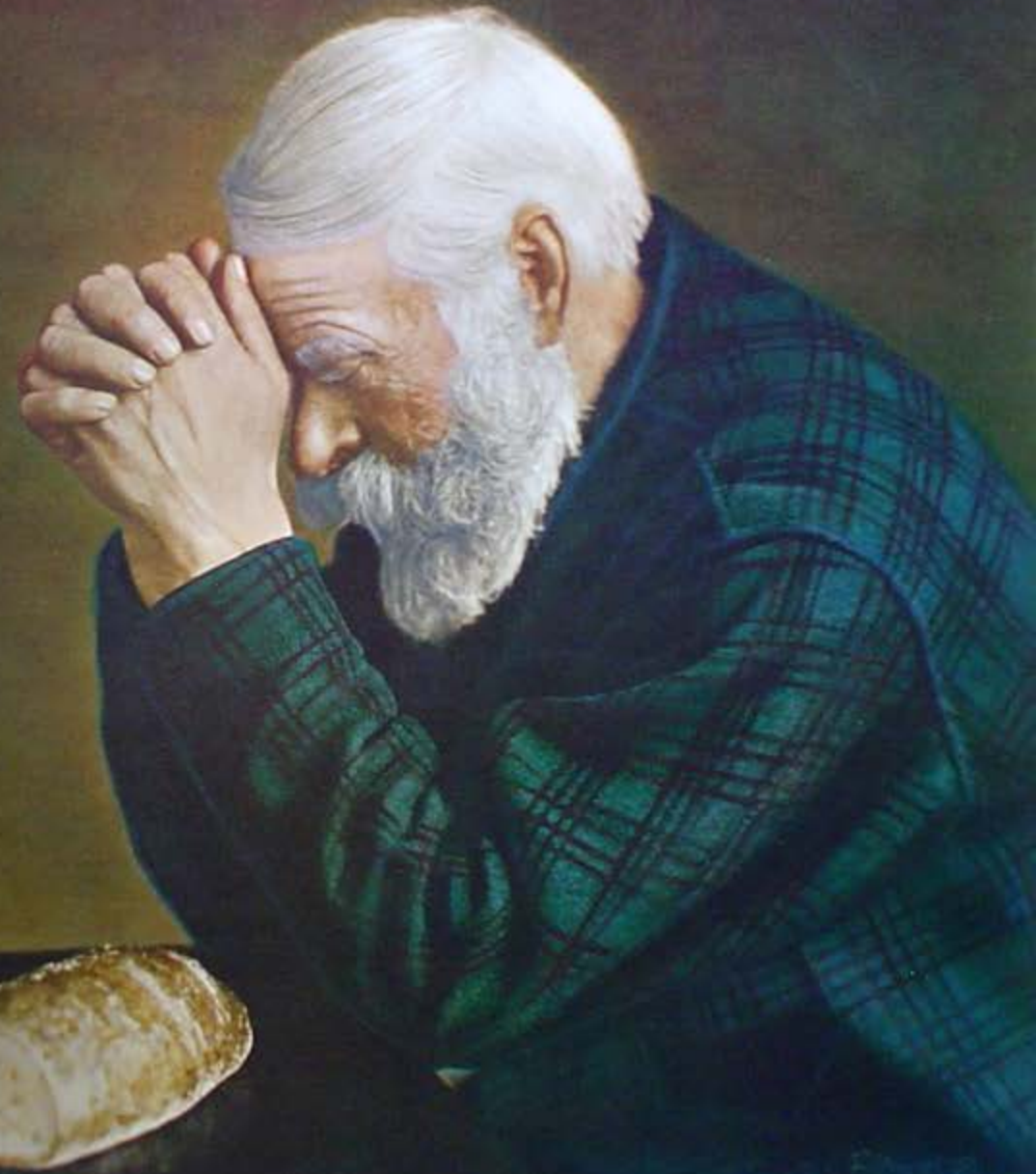

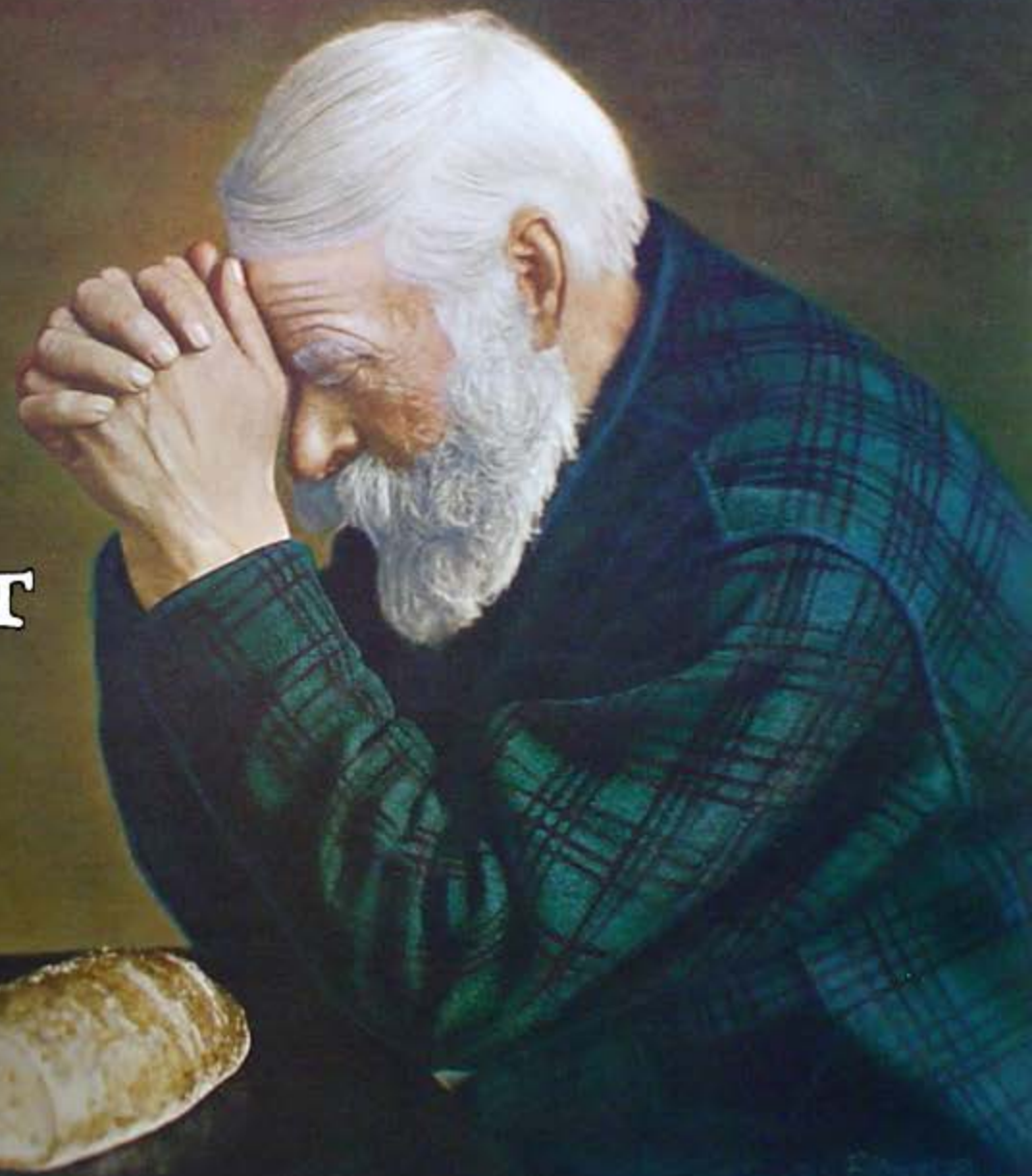
The PROUD trust their own decision making and their own understanding and that can lead to DESTRUCTION.



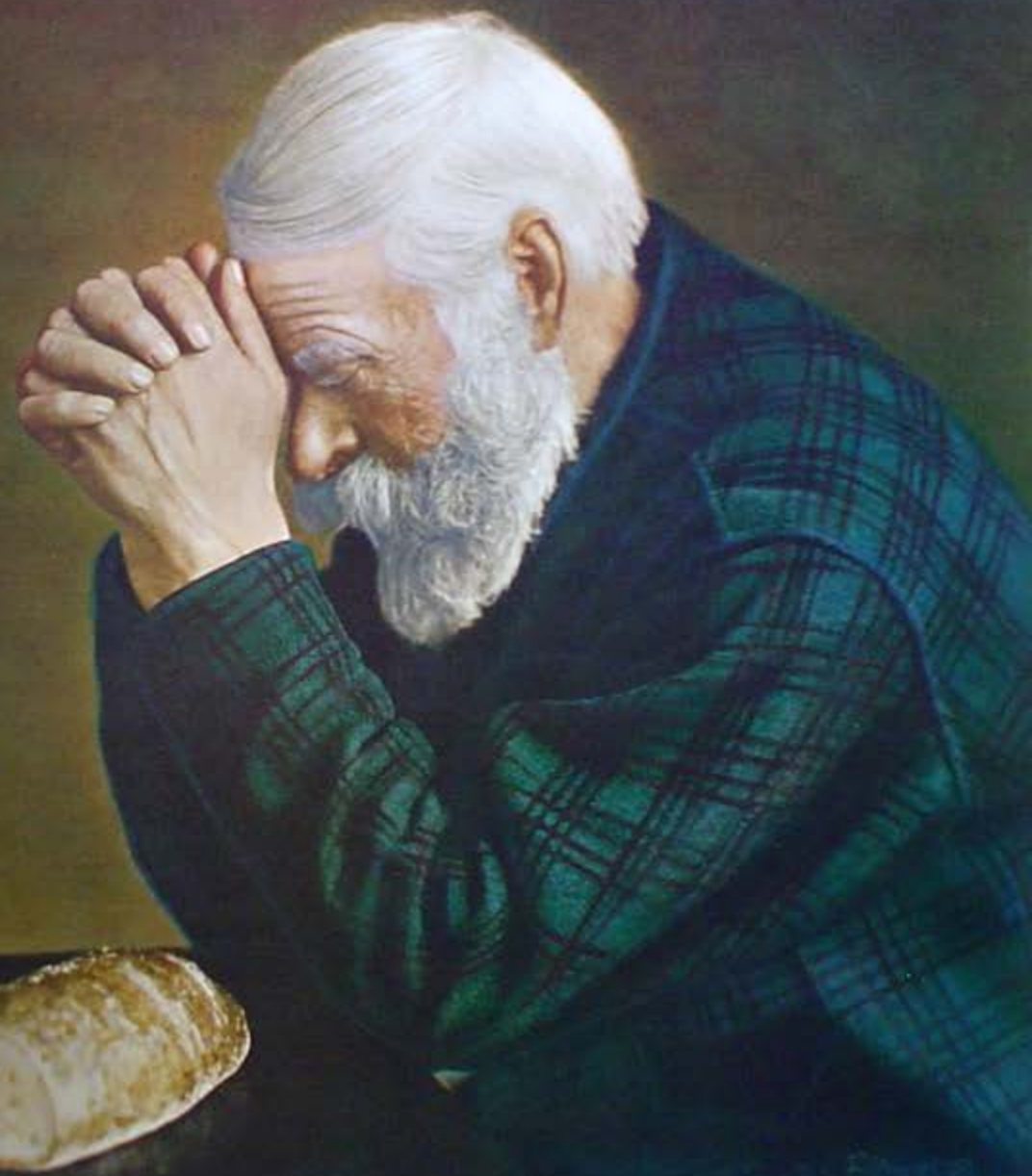

PERFECTED IN JESUS.

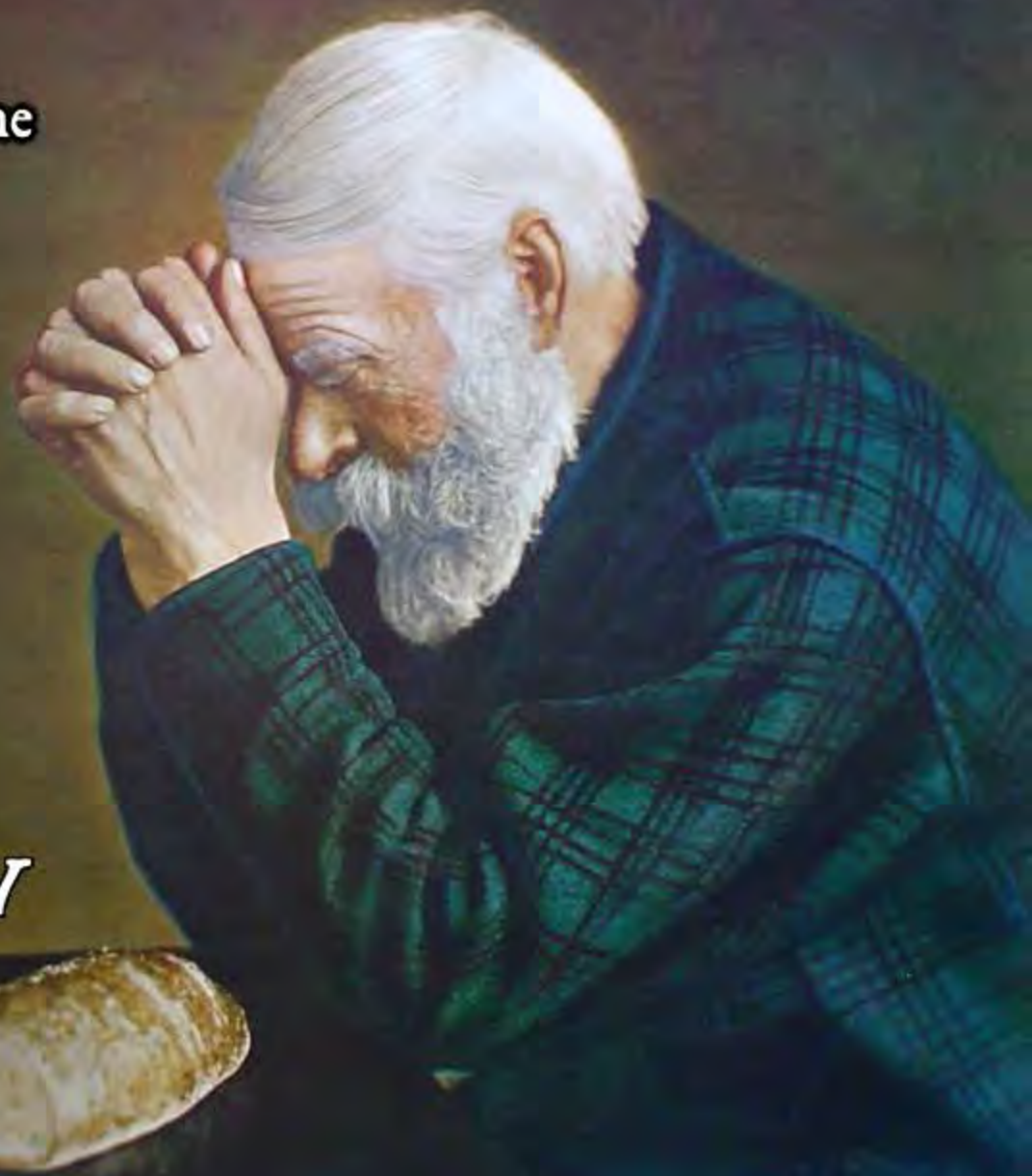

<sup>7</sup> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

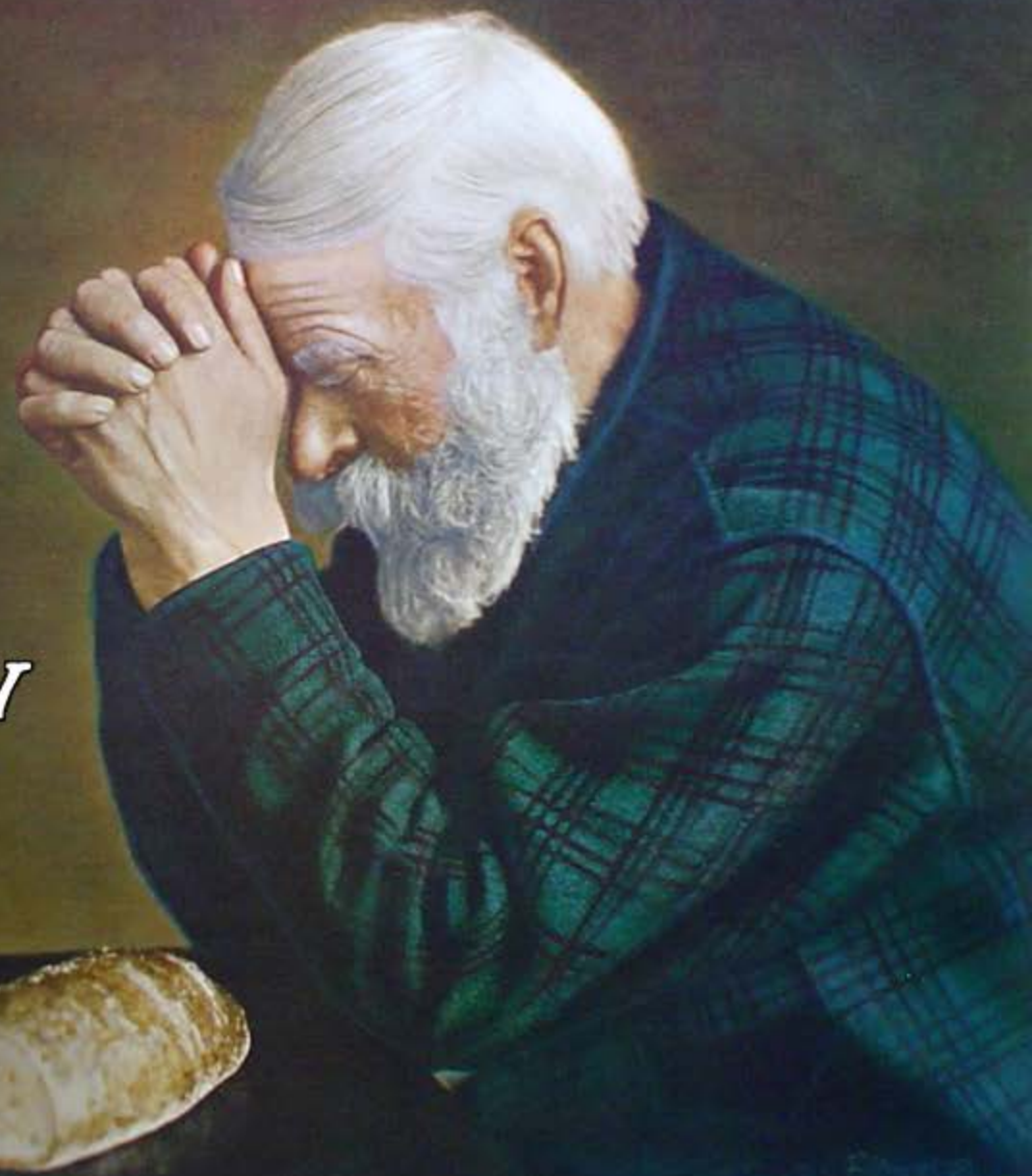

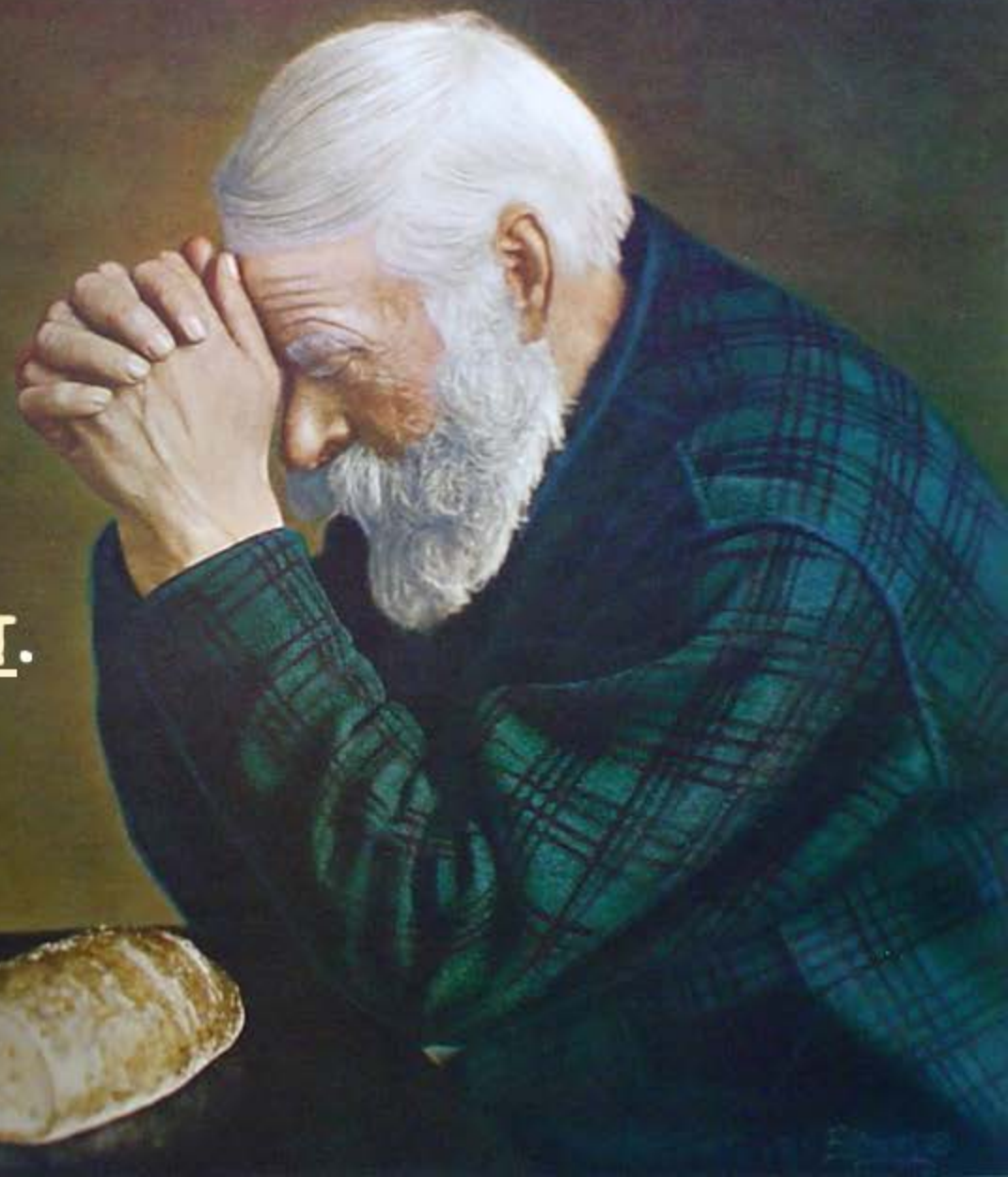

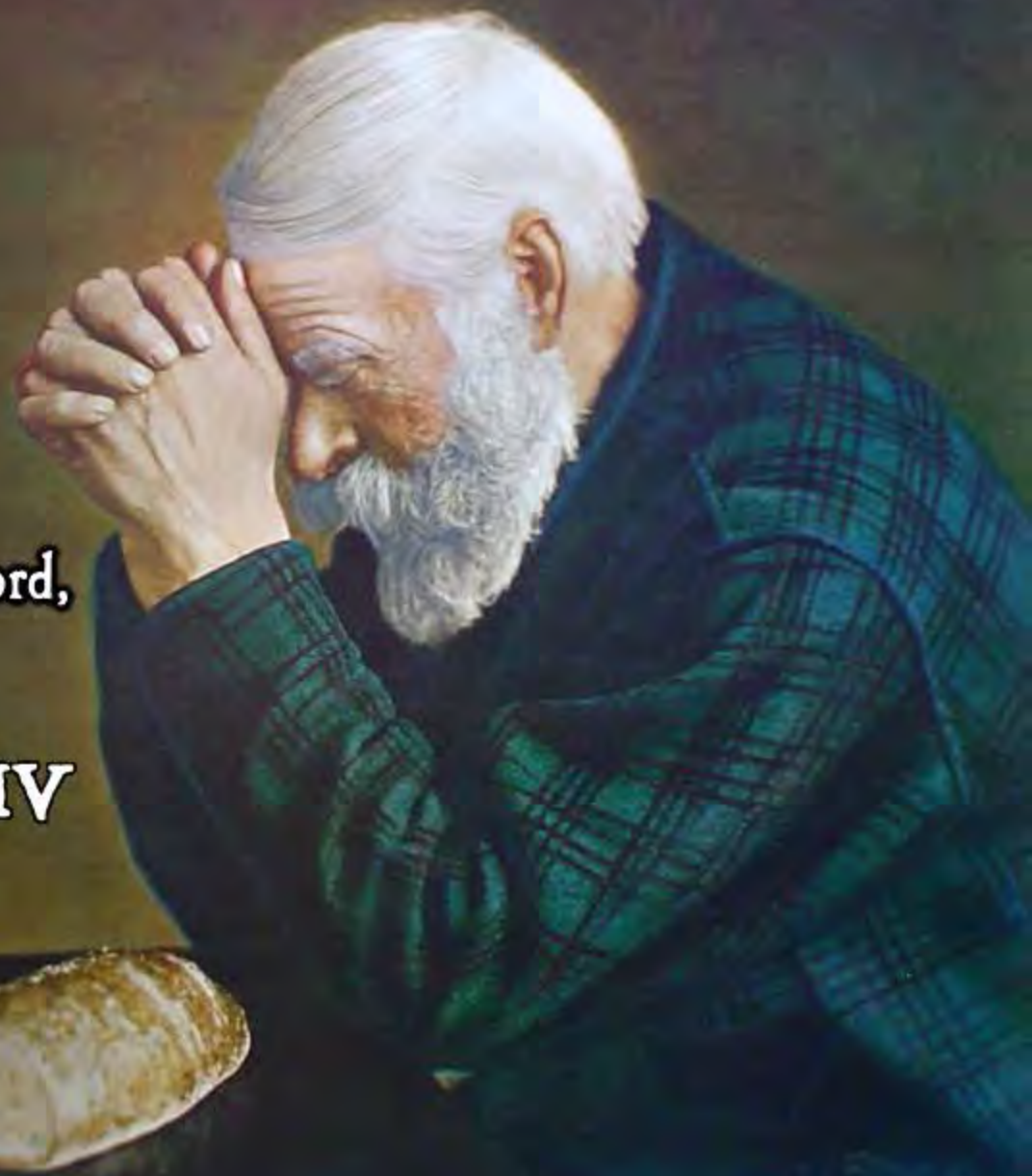
What was broken with pride

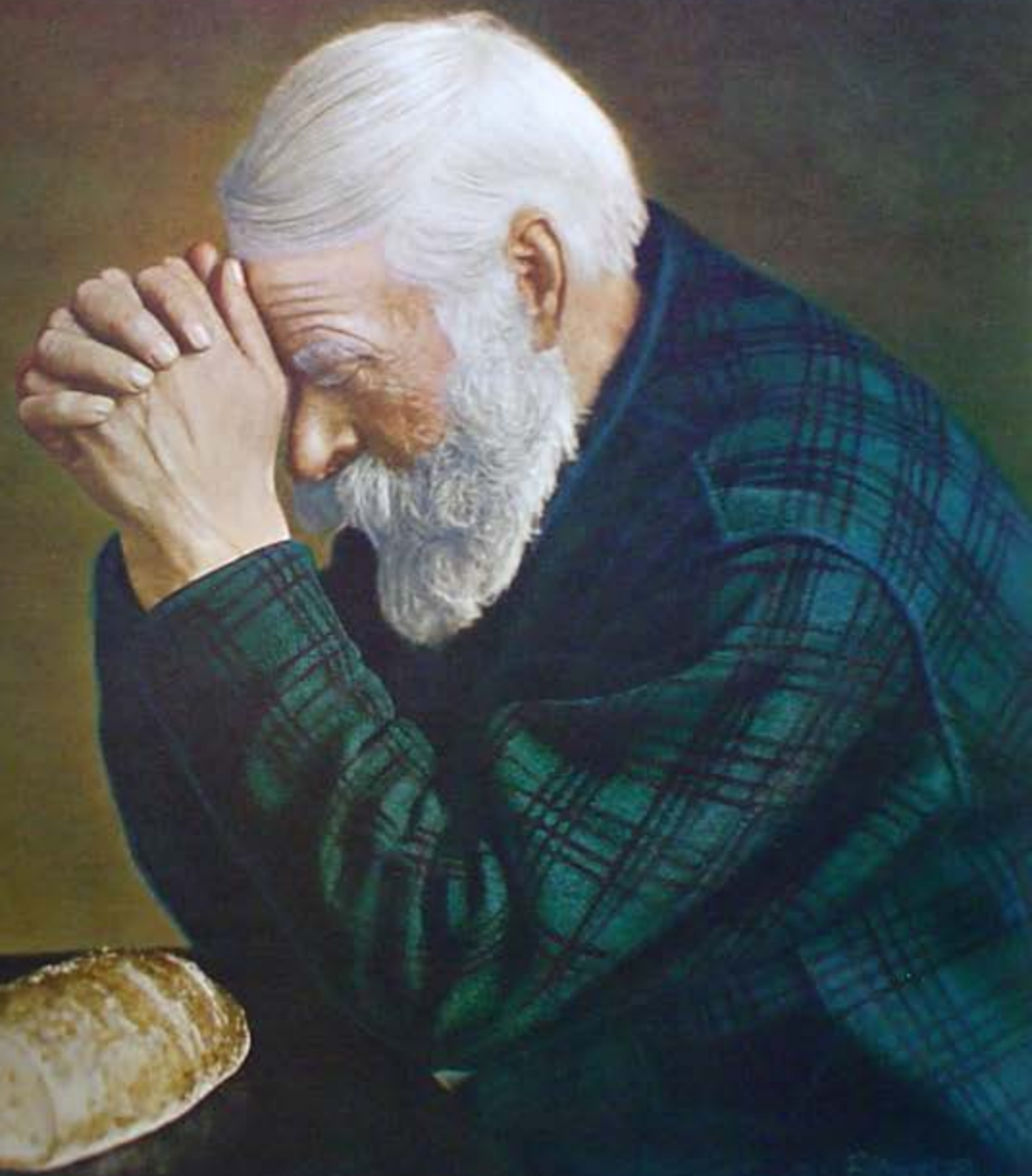
