


²⁵I have thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, and your



The ancient Greek word for "ministered" is the word that would be used for priestly service.

The ancient Greek phrase "risking his life" uses a gambler's word that meant to risk everything on the roll of the dice. Paul wrote that for the sake of Jesus Christ, Epaphroditus was willing to gamble everything.

Epaphroditus was willing to gamble his earthly life because he knew, concerning his eternal life, he could not lose.
