



Living a life of generosity and living open-handed isn't just talking about MONEY, it is talking about everything that FLOWS from our lives.

⁶Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.



It starts with being generous with what you have because generosity is not tied to your RESOURCES, it is tied to your HEART.

¹⁰Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

As we live open-handed, God will put seeds in our hands so that we can sow it. That seed will produce a harvest of righteousness and it will result in an enriched life in faith so that other people can give THANKSGIVING to God.








generous and willing to share. ¹⁹In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.







You should remember the words of the Lord Jesus: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

...and all goes well for the generous man who conducts his business fairly.


⁶Such a man will not be overthrown by evil circumstances. God's constant care of him will make a deep impression on all who see it.

¹⁰Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the Lord your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to.




⁹They share freely and give generously to those in need. Their good deeds will be remembered forever. They will have influence and honor.
