
### JOHN 15:1-8 NIV

The word Jesus uses here is the Greek word *meno*. Jesus uses it 10 times in the first 10 verses of John 15.

# A deeper look at a <u>vital</u> word.



The Greek word *meno* is a <u>verb</u> that means to <u>abide</u>, remain, stay or continue.





# <u>Detachment</u> from the vine always results in <u>decay</u>




It is sobering to know that you can be in the vineyard and still not be <u>connected</u> to <u>Jesus</u>.









**PRESENCE** 


We have a responsibility to <u>cultivate</u> our hearts for His presence.


while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. <sup>3</sup>You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you.

### DEPENDENCE JOHN 15:2B-3 NIV


...apart from me you can do nothing.

### 1 John 2:3-6 NIV

³We know that we have come to know him if we keep his commands. ⁴Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. ⁵But if anyone obeys his word, love for God is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in him: ⁶Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did.
